Early Trailer Drop Off

Trailers can be dropped beginning on Thursday 10/17 at 5:00pm.

Camping:

All campers, motor homes, toterhomes or 5^" wheel trailers will be assessed a \$25 "RV parking pass" fee by Mid O. Tents are excluded from this fee

Electric:

Electric at \$50 per hookup and 220v Electric at \$100 per hookup must be arranged ten (10) days prior to event with Mid O. (Locations and spaces are very limited).

Garages:

Garages are available to rent for \$100 for the whole event. Garage and Pit Box sign ups are now live in our registration system once you are paid in full.

Other:

Any charges associated with registering pit vehicles are the responsibility of the participants.

Snack Bar:

The Snack Bar will be open for breakfast and lunch Friday, Saturday and Sunday

Crew (to get into pits)

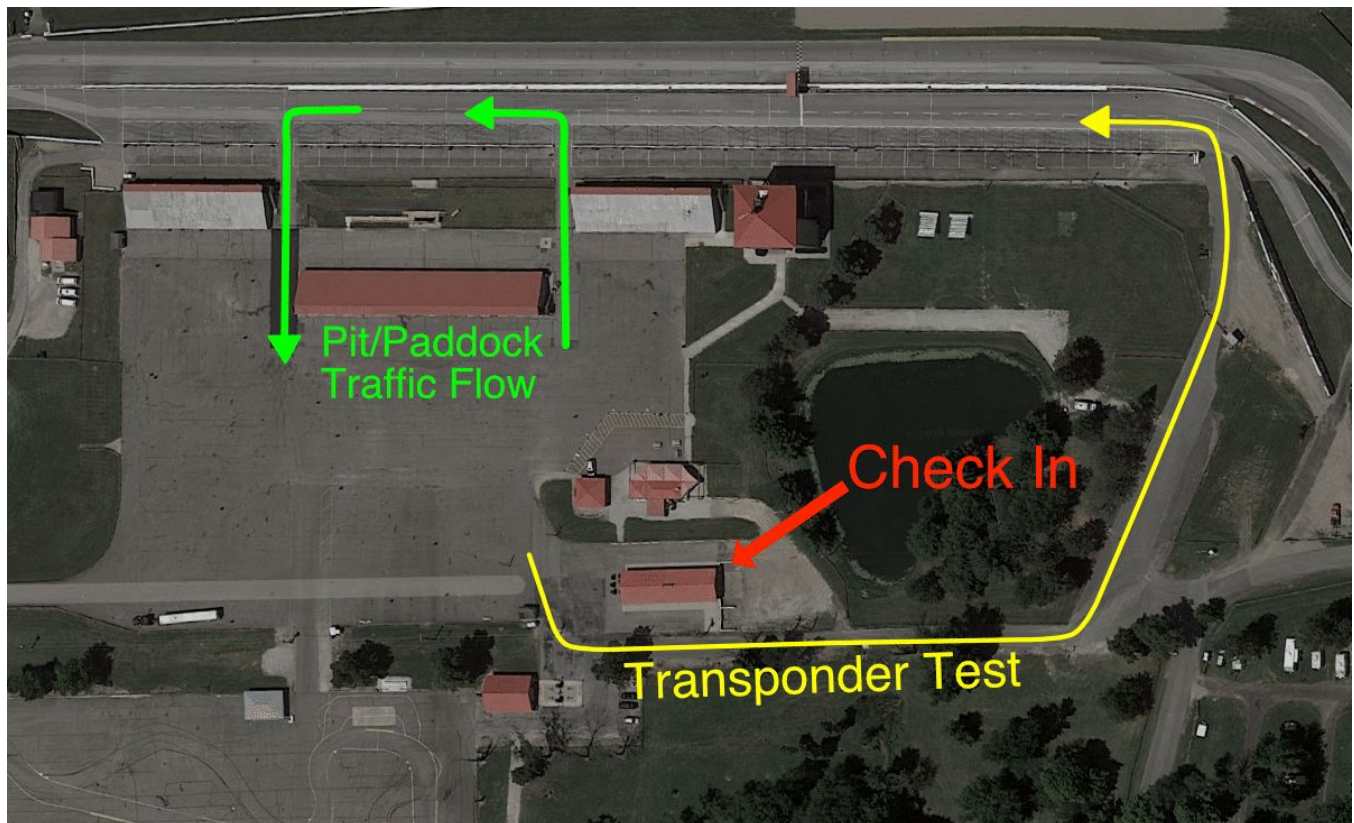
- Sign AER release & receive a red wristband

Minors

- Anyone under the age of 18 by the event date at Mid-Ohio must submit a minor waiver to Mid-Ohio's Chief Registrar ten (10) days prior to event. All parents/guardians of minors should be instructed to contact Tammi Griffith 419-884-4000 ex. 3007. Absolutely no minors under the age of 16 years of age by the rental date can participate in on track activities.

Cars (to get on track)

- Race Cars: get car teched, receive car RFID and 2017 tech stickers (yearly)
- Street Cars: get car teched, receive car sticker

Supplemental Rules for Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course

Paddock Safety:

Pedestrians, bikes, scooters, skateboards, etc, please give way to race cars. This is an active paddock. Cars will be moving around and need to have clear pathways available at all times.

Parents, you are responsible for your children at all times.

Pit Road Safety:

No smoking anywhere on pit road.

Long pants and closed-toed shoes are required to access pit road.

Pit Lane Speed: 35mph except when approaching the RFID Scanner Array, then 5mph.

Paddock Speed: 15mph

You are responsible for all damages you cause at the following rate:

1. Oil Dry - \$20/bag (Based on actual usage)
2. Damaged guard rail replacement - \$1,000.00 per section
3. Damaged concrete barrier replacement - \$1,000.00 per section
4. Damaged tire wall bundle replacement - \$500.00 per bundle
5. Damaged debris fencing replacement - \$1,000 per section
6. Damaged conveyor belting replacement - \$100.00 per foot
7. Damaged catch fence post replacement - \$100.00 per post
8. Fire incident - \$300.00 per fire bottle
9. Damaged tow strap - \$50 per tow strap
