Garages, Pit Boxes & Race Car Tech are available to rent/reserve, in our registration system. These options will be visible once you are paid in full for the event. Garages spaces are \$100 for the entire event. Tech inspections are \$200 at the track (paid to the shop performing the inspection at the track). Tech inspections are \$150 at our [Tech Inspectors](#) before the event.

Paddock Parking

The parking spots directly adjacent to each garage are reserved for the team renting said garage.

Drivers & Crew

- Must have an account at race.americanenduranceracing.com
- Must be added to your registration
 - From your Team Dashboard > Upcoming Registered Events > AER at The Glen 2019 > Edit Car, Driver & Crew
- Once added to a registration Drivers and Crew will receive a link via email to sign our eWaiver/Gear Certification.
- Our eWaiver/Gear Certification only needs to be signed once every 12 months.
- Check in at the track in the classroom or from one of our roving staff and receive a wrist band (green for drivers, red for crew)

Minors

- No individual under the age of eighteen (18) years of age shall be allowed on the track in vehicles or in any restricted area of the Premises (which shall include the track surface, pit areas, run-off areas, trackside communications stations, and any other location “beyond the fence”. Participants must be eighteen (18) years of age.

Race Cars

- Must be Tech'd once per season
- Please make every effort to have this done at one of our [Tech Inspectors](#) before the event.
- A limited number of spots will be available to sign up for once you are paid in full.
