Transponder & RFID Test

All cars that will be racing must complete the following procedure

- 1. Line up at pit out RFID reader
- 2. Wait to be waived through by AER staff
- 3. Continue onto race track and complete one lap
- 4. Exit track at pit in
- 5. Roll through pit in RFID reader
- 6. Stop for AER staff to either receive "pass" sticker or instructions.
- 7. Items to be tested:
 - a. Transponder active & correct in timing system
 - b. Car's RFID tag active & correct in timing system
 - c. Car possesses AER 2018 Tech Sticker
 - d. Car possesses full AER Sticker Pack

Additional Notes

- 1. Pit Lane Speed: 35mph except when approaching the RFID Scanner Array, then 5mph. Paddock Speed: 10mph
- 2. There is 93 octane fuel at the automated pumps in the paddock.
- 3. The sound level limit for all vehicles is 103dB, measured 50 feet from the centerline of the track. Measurement is made on the A weighting scale, slow response. Vehicles not complying must rectify the situation before returning to the track.
- 4. Chez Summit will be open from 7:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Friday & Sunday. 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Saturday.
